Tournament Rules

GAMES:

- Games will be of 4 quarters of 8 Minutes duration; stopping clock. There will be a 30-second interval between quarters with a 3 minute half time.
- 12 players are allowed to play in each game.
- Time - outs shall be of 45 seconds duration and will be limited to one per team in each quarter. These are non-transferable into any other quarter.
- The team fouls penalty will apply after 4 fouls in each 8 minute period.
- 5 personal fouls allowed
- Normal rules will apply regarding substitution of players.
- 3 points for a win & 1 point for a loss

OVERTIME:

- Periods of overtime will be of 3 minutes duration until a result is achieved with one 45-second time out per period

TEAM COLOURS:

The first named team (home team) on the schedule shall wear shall wear lighter colour kits – unless agreed upon with the opposition team before hand.

ADDITIONAL:

In the event of a tie in the group, the following shall happen:

- A head to head between the two teams tied will determine positioning.
