### JOB PURPOSE

Milton Keynes Basketball Club is looking to recruit a dedicated full-time basketball Community Coach to help the growth of basketball in the area. The work will focus on the coaching of young people at school and club sessions. It will also include coaching school teams including individual/team sessions and games. The coach will be expected to help attract new players to Milton Keynes Basketball Club's satellite clubs and Junior National League sessions. The coach will also have the opportunity to coach within Milton Keynes Basketball Club's Junior National League programme. Travelling with teams will also be part of the role. The appointed coach will be required to work alongside voluntary coaches. You must have a minimum of a Level 2 NGB Coaching award. You will also be a confident verbal communicator who can plan coaching sessions and have the ability to motivate yourself and others, as well as working as a team member. The successful candidate will be asked to apply for a criminal disclosure check through the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). A conviction (spent or unspent) may not exclude candidates from this position but will be considered as part of the recruitment process.

### KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- To delivery high quality coaching sessions which revolve around player enjoyment, engagement and retention
- Establish appropriate links and partnerships (schools and clubs) that will assist in the development of the sport in the area
- Actively market and promote Milton Keynes Basketball Club
- Administration including:
  - To coordinate and sell basketball coaching services to schools, mainly junior and primary schools.
  - To undertake the necessary planning for community and team sessions to ensure that the programme demonstrates progression throughout.
  - To ensure that accurate records are maintained, and the appropriate paperwork is completed.
  - To collect participants coaching fees, where necessary, in accordance with procedures.
  - Work with the Milton Keynes Basketball Club Club Chairman to develop and encourage progression of activities through to the community club environment.
  - To understand and implement the policies and procedures as they relate to the delivery of services to young people; in particular the Data Protection Act, Health and Safety, Equal Opportunities and Child Protection policies, and codes of conduct as they relate to coaches.

- To keep up to date with all current coaching practices and undertake all the mandatory training required

## SECONDARY FUNCTIONS

- To respect the rights of the participants and ensure that their well-being and safety is considered at all times.
- To liaise with local authorities, governing body officers, schools, sports clubs and other organisations to advocate the work of the Milton Keynes Basketball Club and the National Governing Body
- To undertake such other duties as may be reasonably required.
