

DECLARATION

The named club hereby applies to compete in the Basketball England League for the 2021/2022 season. In submitting and paying for this application, the club agrees to abide by the Basketball England Code of Ethics and Conduct and the Basketball England NBL Rules and Regulations. The club acknowledges a full understanding of the following statements.

- 1. Team(s) applying to compete must have a dedicated licensed coach with a Level 2 qualification or above (a minimum of one coach per team)
- 2. Teams should currently have a minimum of 10 players available for each squad
- 3. The club understands that if entering more than one team, it must fulfil all fixtures, even if the fixture schedule(s) require that the teams need to play at different venues on the same day
- 4. Our team(s) will prioritise National League games before ALL other fixtures, and no league game may be postponed unless there are exceptional circumstances. We understand that after 31st August 2021, only the tip time can be changed. Should a facility issue arise, we will follow the rules and regulations. Failure to fulfil a fixture may result in a fine or loss of points.
- 5. Basketball England will be notified of ALL fixture changes / amendments at least 72 hours before the event and that no fixture will be changed without prior approval of Basketball England and your scheduled opposition
