About Us

Established in 2018, Let's Do More CIC, is a socially inspired organisation, which uses sport as a means to engage, empower and raise the aspirations of young people living in some of the most deprived communities in Leeds. Since 2019, basketball has become our flagship sport and the LDM Basketball programme engages over 200 young people each week in basketball activity across multiple communities in Leeds.

The LDM Basketball programme is designed to provide basketball opportunities to players from all backgrounds and experiences, providing a pathway to the elite level of the game for those who aspire to pursue this. We have 4 teams competing in the English Junior National Basketball League and work in partnership with Leeds City College, to run a basketball academy for players aged 16-19, providing aspiring athletes an opportunity to mix basketball alongside studying for an academic qualification.

Role & Responsibilities

Our junior basketball programme based in Leeds, West Yorkshire is growing and we require dedicated coaches to support the development of our young players and teams. We currently have 4 teams in the English Junior NBL structure and various teams competing in local competition with prospective coaches supporting the head coach in designing and delivering initiative training sessions with the core aim of engaging and developing young players in the sport of basketball. The main roles and responsibilities included in the role include:



- Designing and delivery of training sessions
- Maintaining high ethical standards in coaching/instructing, ensure they keep up-to-date with their knowledge, skills and qualifications and prepare all sessions in advance.
- Undertaking training appropriate to the role e.g child protection training
- Attending club meetings where appropriate and report on progress
- Assist in selections of teams where appropriate
- Travel to competitions with teams where appropriate
- Taking responsibility for personal conflicts of interest and declaring, recording and managing these appropriately.
