ANTI-DOPING ANNUAL SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES 2021

Introduction

This resource is in support of UKAD Assurance Framework. This report outlines a summary of activities conducted by Basketball England over the last year as part of its ongoing promotion of Clean Sport within Basketball.

Basketball England condemns, and is totally opposed to, the use of performance enhancing drugs and doping practices in the sport of basketball and fully supports the position of the International Olympic Committee, the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), UK Anti-Doping and FIBA against the use of banned substances and methods.

Clean Sport Education Strategy and Implementation Plan

2022 will see the introduction of the revised anti-doping strategy for basketball as part of the new UKAD Assurance Programme. Our mission for the next 2 years is to protect the integrity of clean sport within Basketball.

Our education strategy aims to target our sport specific needs and key anti-doping topics, in line with UKAD's clean sport curriculum. These topics will cover; principles and values of clean sport, strict liability, rights and responsibilities of players, coaches and support personnel, consequence of doping, anti-doping rule violations, the prohibited list, supplements, mediations & TUE's, the testing process, testing pools and ADAMS where applicable, how to report doping and substances of abuse.

Coaches and Support Personnel will also have specific anti-doping education opportunities relevant to their role.

Education

At the end of 2021, Basketball England had two qualified UKAD Educators and nine UKAD advisors.

24 senior players received Clean Sport Education session at the England 3x3 Camp in Manchester.

All Players, Coaches and Support Personnel received information regarding the prohibited list changes for 2022.

Compliance

Basketball England has provided evidence against the UKAD Assurance Framework requirements for approval by UKAD.

Testing

Tests are conducted by UKAD on behalf of 60 National Governing Bodies, International Federations and National Anti-Doping Organisations. The table below shows the number of successful tests completed by UKAD in basketball This table will be continually updated.
