The job will include coaching in schools as part of our Let's Play Ball programme, community sessions, mini ballers and Crusaders Basketball Leagues (CBL).

There will be an expectation to coach with Kent Crusaders national league teams. Ideally we will appoint one coach who will work with our boys' programmes and one who will work with our girls' programmes.
