

Crew Chief End of Game Scoresheet Checks

The crew chief (first named referee) is responsible for ensuring that the scoresheet is an accurate and complete record of the game. The scoresheet is an official document and must be correct.

To help crew chiefs fulfil their responsibility in checking the scoresheet before being the <u>last</u> <u>to sign</u> it, listed below are some key items to check for.



Oreen box – no blank spaces or empty boxes, all licence numbers included for players and coaches

3 – Blue box – the quarter scores add up to the final scores for both teams

Image - Blue box – the name of the winning team is written correctly; the time the game ended is clearly written.

9 – Orange box – the protest box either has a captain's signature in it or it is ruled through clearly.
